- 1. Call to Order President Perry Batchelor called the meeting to order at 12:06 p.m.

 - Altona Curling Club \$1,000 sound system
 - Bergthal School Project \$3,500 completion costs
 - Altona Maroons Minor Hockey \$2,000 jerseys
 - Rosenfeld Good Neighbour Centre \$3,000 roof repair/kitchen upgrades
