

Minutes of the Altona Community Foundation Board of Directors held on Friday, June 17, 2016 at 12:00 pm at Golden West Broadcasting boardroom.

#### 1. Call to Order

President Perry Batchelor called the meeting to order at 12:07 p.m.

## 2. Review of the Agenda

#### 3. Review of Previous Minutes

### 4. Financial Report

John reviewed the attached financial report with the board.

#### 5. Build a Village – Grant Payment

- Raised garden beds were built jointly with Build a Village and Gardens on Tenth.
- Gardens on Tenth built and paid bill should we pay Gardens on Tenth even though costs were below project amount applied for.
- Board agreed to pay full amount of \$1,200 with an explanation letter.
- Granting policy to be revised to state volunteer labour is to be excluded from project costs.

#### 6. Canadian Cancer Society

- The board received a letter from the Canadian Cancer Society expressing their disappointment over receiving only \$350 vs. \$700 due to reduced project costs.
- Board will stand by decision and Perry/Jenn will issue letter.

## 7. Relish Design - Invoice

Board will pay \$169 to Relish Designs for website maintenance.

#### 8. Altona United Way

- Ken Wiebe met with Perry to discuss alternatives as Ken will no longer be involved with the United Way and they cannot continue to operate under the United Way banner.
- Board opted not to get involved at this time.
- Regional route is likely their best alternative.

#### 9. Chamber Banquet

- Perry thanked all the board members that were involved.
- John reported \$3,330 was raised via a BBQ raffle, \$1,480 and a silent auction, \$1,850.
