

Minutes of the Altona Community Foundation Board of Directors online meeting held on Friday, May 7, 2021 at 12:00 pm.

Present were: president, Loren Braul; treasurer, Angus Klassen; Chris Sumner; Bill Penner; Tracy Klassen; Scott Penner; Pat Friesen; Ken Wiebe, and Keith Stoesz.

#### 1. Call to Order

Loren Braul called the meeting to order at 12:04 p.m.

#### 2. Review of the Agenda

MOTION: Bill Penner - moved - Pat Friesen - seconded - THAT the agenda is approved as presented. CARRIED.

#### 3. Review of Previous Minutes

MOTION: Ken Wiebe - moved - Keith Stoesz - seconded - THAT the minutes of the meeting held March 17, 2021 are adopted as circulated. CARRIED.

#### 4. YIP

- Student rep Willow Kehler reported they received several grant applications.
- Chris to setup a meeting with YIP to review the granting process and applications.
- During the 2020-2021 school year YIP raised \$273 by holding an online fundraiser. That money is matched by ACF, with the additional funds coming from the YIP account, YIP has \$760 available to grant.

#### 5. Financial

- The following cheque was issued to: Curtis Klassen Memorial Fund, \$3,500.
- Jenn to send a letter along with the initial funds to The Winnipeg Foundation to establish the ACF Future Ag Leader Scholarship and the Bergfeld Mennonite Church Missions Fund.
- Angus presented the attached financial reports to the board prior to the meeting via email.

MOTION: Angus Klassen - moved - Scott Penner - seconded - THAT the attached financial reports are approved as presented.

#### CARRIED.

Angus presented a draft operating budget to the board. Do we want to invest in more admin at this point? Loren to reach out to Endow MB about Morden's f/t admin person. Board to review again at the June meeting.

#### 6. Spring Grant Applications

- 2021 spring granting: five applications received three were accepted, two were denied.
- Board had \$35,000 to disperse.
- Keith went through the scoring guide with the board.
- Board confirmed the following \$9,743 in grant requests:
  - o Kiddie Sunshine Centre, \$3,500 outdoor hand washing station
  - Altona Family Resource Centre \$3,600 computer for coordinator
  - Gardens on Tenth \$2.643 common area furniture

**MOTION:** Keith Stoesz – moved – Angus Klassen – seconded – THAT the Altona Community Foundation approve the 2021 spring grant requests as presented. **CARRIED.** 

- Letters to be mailed to approved and declined grant applicants.
- Press release to be sent to media.
- According to our by-laws ACF grants only support capital not operating. United Way in Altona used
  to fund operating grants in our area. Check with other foundations to see if they fund operating
  grants. Put on agenda at the next planning session meeting.

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- After the meeting, four more grant applications were found in the ACF spam folder. All were submitted before the granting deadline, granting committee reconvened to review the additional applications.
- The granting committee rescinds the granting motion from our meeting on Friday, May 7 and replaces it with a motion made on Thursday, May 13 approving \$35,000 in grant payments to the revised applicants:
  - o Kiddie Sunshine Centre, \$3,500 outdoor hand washing station
  - o Altona Family Resource Centre \$3,600 computer for coordinator
  - o Gardens on Tenth \$2,200 common area furniture
  - o Youth for Christ Altona, \$15,000 expansion
  - o Parkside Parent Council, \$8,000 outdoor classroom improvements
  - o Blue Sky Opportunities, \$2,000 storage shed to become e-waste certified
  - Neubergthal Heritage Foundation, \$700 roller blinds for classroom

**MOTION:** Keith Stoesz – moved – Tracy Klassen – seconded – THAT the Altona Community Foundation approve the revised 2021 spring grant requests as presented. **CARRIED.** 

### 7. ACF Future Ag Scholarship

- Jenn to send grant application to Chris to distribute to W.C. Miller and MCI.

#### 8. Neuberathal Heritage Fund

- The Manitoba Heritage Trust Program (MHTP) created the Manitoba Heritage Trust Endowment Fund (MHTE) from the residual stretch funds of MHTP. This permanent endowment fund will generate ongoing stretch dollars for heritage funds in perpetuity.
- NHF has received gifts totalling \$2,500. As of March 31, 2021 the NHF has increased their capital of their fund to \$3,750.

# Manitoba Heritage Trust Program



As of April 1, 2021, the Manitoba Heritage Trust Program (MHTP) will create the Manitoba Heritage Trust Endowment Fund (MHTE) from the residue of the MHTP. The MHTE fund, which will now be a permanent endowment fund, will annually generate matching for heritage funds into perpetuity.

The following is a summary for the established MHTP funds:

- All funds created under the original program will be eligible for continuing matching into perpetuity.
- The original Guaranteed Government Match still applies to funds that have received less than \$25,000 in matching.
- New! Heritage organizations may use any type of non-government derived funding sources to build their MHTP fund (for example: gifts from individuals or businesses, held over operating funds, fundraising from events held prior, and unused funds from capital accounts, etc.)
- Capitalization of the spending generated from the MHTP Fund is still not allowed (the use of the income generated from a heritage fund is at the discretion of the heritage organization, but please note that the fund is designed to help offset operational costs).
- New! Gifts to a heritage fund can be tax receipted by the heritage organization (if they are a registered charity), the local community foundation or The Winnipeg Foundation. All receipted gifts must be added to the capital of the heritage fund each year by September 30.
- As per the original MHTP agreement, and if the community foundation is not under an affiliate agreement with Endow Manitoba, the community foundation can choose to have the fund moved back into its own investment pool. It is advised that the community foundation consult the heritage organization prior to requesting the transfer of the investment.
- New! If the local foundation chooses to have the fund managed under their investment pool, then the foundation will need to annually submit an application form by October 7 to Endow Manitoba to access the available stretch dollars. (form to follow)
- As per the original MHTP agreement, all heritage funds that remain invested with Endow Manitoba under their local foundation (including funds at The Winnipeg Foundation) will now be transferred under their foundation's current managed agreement and will fall under the spending and fee rates as determined annually by the local community foundation or their managed agreement.
- New! The stretch dollars will be allocated from the grant making activity the is available for distribution from the Manitoba Heritage Trust Endowment Fund. For every \$2 given to the fund the program will stretch the gift with an additional \$1, if the funds available from the Manitoba Heritage Trust Endowment Fund are insufficient to payout at the \$1 for \$2 rate then stretch will be applied on a pro-rated basis. Deadline for qualifying gifts is September 30 each year, (Guaranteed matching will occur first then the residue will be pro-rate to a max of the 1:2 rate)
