Minutes of the Altona Community Foundation Board of Directors held on Friday, December 14, 2018 at 12:00 pm in the Golden West boardroom at Golden West Broadcasting.

Present were: president, Chris Sumner; vice-president, Loren Braul; treasurer, Wendy Dyck; Bill Penner: Brenda Thiesen: Keith Stoesz: Ken Wiebe: Tracy Klassen and Scott Penner.

1. Call to Order

Chris Sumner called the meeting to order at 12:02 p.m.

2. Review of the Agenda

4. CIBC Presentation

- Quinn Friesen from CIBC and Alf Hughes, investment advisor and Peter Kobar, portfolio manager made an investment presentation to the board reviewing what they could offer the ACF.

5. Financial

- Wendy issued the following grant cheques that are ready to present: Gardens on Tenth, century tub - \$5,500; Gretna Beautification Team (Municipality of Rhineland), bison sculpture - \$1,200; and Rhineland Child Care, upgrade shelving/couch - \$700.
- A number of grants have come in recently that have needed to be pro-rated. Currently or guidelines state: "Whereas when projects that have been approved for a grant come in under the cost indicated on the grant application, the ACF has the right to reduce the grant by the per cent that the project cost was reduced. After some discussion the board decided to revise the guideline to eliminate any gray areas. Jennifer to send revised guideline wording to board prior to next meeting.
- Wendy reported that the ACF has \$196 in operations. As in past years, money raised at the Earl Dick Memorial Golf Tournament has been designated towards the ACF operation account.

MOTION: Wendy Dyck - moved - Bill Penner - seconded - THAT the \$1,792 raised at the 2018 Earl Dick Memorial Golf Tournament be designated towards the ACF's operation account.

Wendy presented the attached financial reports to the board.

MOTION: Wendy Dyck - moved - Chris Sumner - seconded - THAT the attached financial reports are approved as presented.
