So far feedback from employers, including both those with and without existing deduction schemes, has been positive.
- Loren will be giving a wills presentation at the Gardens on Tenth on April 25 @ 7 p.m. Last year Bill spoke on behalf of the ACF at the presentation – looking for a volunteer from the board that is available to speak this year.
