Minutes of the Altona Community Foundation Board of Directors held on Friday, January 18, 2019 at 12:00 pm in the Golden West boardroom at Golden West Broadcasting.

Present were: president, Chris Sumner; vice-president, Loren Braul; treasurer, Wendy Dyck;

#### 1. Call to Order

Chris Sumner called the meeting to order at 12:04 p.m.

#### 2. Review of the Agenda

MOTION: Bill Penner - moved - Scott Penner - seconded - THAT the agenda is approved as presented.

#### 3. Review of Previous Minutes

MOTION: Tracy Klassen - moved - Brenda Thiesen - seconded - THAT the minutes of the meeting held December 14, 2018 are adopted as circulated.

#### 4. YIP

- W.C. Miller teacher Vanessa Zacharias, Grade 9 rep Abby, Grade 11 rep Baraa reported a tentative date of March 1 for their movie night fundraiser. They will be showing the movie Storks, snacks will be for sale and entrance will be by donation.
- Still looking at a date for a soup & pie fundraiser and a tentative bake sale.
- YIP grant applications should be in by the end of April.

#### 5. Financial

- ACF financials have been provided to GTP for the review of engagement. They provided an approximate cost of \$3,000.
- ACF receives money from vending machine sales this money will be moved to operating.
- The \$1,792 from the Earl Dick Memorial Golf Tournament still needs to be moved to operating.
- We received an Administrative Support Grant in the amount of \$1,450.63 from The Winnipeg Foundation. This amount was added to our bank account on December 14 and will be moved to operating.
- Discussion entailed on the current state of our operating account and how we will need more money in this account in the months ahead. Wendy supplied a comparison from 2017 to 2018.
- Neubergthal Heritage Foundation did not submit enough invoices for the total project cost of \$3,000 on their 2018 fall grant of \$1,200 for a commercial drink cooler. The total project cost came in at \$2,825 – 94% of the total project cost. Proven expenditures were close to the 95% and since they demonstrated the project was completed as intended the board decided not to pro-rate the grant.

**MOTION:** Bill Penner – moved – Brenda Thiesen – seconded – THAT the Altona Community Foundation not pro-rate the 2018 fall grant to the Neubergthal Heritage Foundation and approve a payment of \$1,200.

Wendy presented the attached financial reports to the board.

**MOTION:** Wendy Dyck – moved – Scott Penner – seconded – THAT the attached financial reports are approved as presented.

#### CARRIED.

- Wendy issued the following grant cheques that are ready to present: Gardens on Tenth, carts/snow blowers/cordless drill \$1,250; Neubergthal Heritage Foundation, sound system/chairs/tables \$2,000; Rosenfeld Good Neighbour Centre, history book project \$1,200; and Altona Curling Club, projector \$1,500. Board discussed that it would be nice to include a congratulatory letter with cheque presentations. Moving forward we will include a letter with the cheque presentations.
- Wendy indicated she is struggling to find time to keep up with the ACF books. She is asking if any other board member is willing to take on the treasurer role.
- Brenda was approached by Ray and Linda Loewen about a donation they made online that they intended to be designated to the Menno H. Friesen Fund. Wendy to transfer the donation into the Menno H. Friesen Fund.
