Minutes of the Altona Community Foundation Board of Directors held on Friday, October 18, 2019 at 12:00 pm in the gold room at Golden West Broadcasting.

Present were: president, Chris Sumner; vice-president, Loren Braul; Keith Stoesz; Tracy Klassen; Ken Wiebe; Bill Penner; Angus Klassen and Pat Friesen. Regrets: Scott Penner

1. Call to Order

Chris Sumner called the meeting to order at 12:03 p.m.

- 2. Welcome New Board Members
 - Chris welcomed two new board members Pat Friesen and Angus Klassen.

MOTION: Bill Penner - moved - Loren Braul - seconded - THAT the Altona Community Foundation board approve the appointment of Angus Klassen as the new treasurer of the Altona Community Foundation and set him to have signing authority and online access on the Altona Community Foundation account.

CARRIED.

3. Review of the Agenda

MOTION: Bill Penner - moved - Tracy Klassen - seconded - THAT the agenda is approved as presented.

CARRIED.

- 4. Review of Previous Minutes
 - Bill noted that the minutes should reflect that non-member Angus Klassen attended the September meeting.
 - Jennifer noted that the September A/P Aging Summary was incorrect. The spring 2018 grant to the Rosenfeld Skating Rink for \$1,200 was withdrawn at the March 15 meeting and should have been moved into the next granting period. The spring 2018 grant to the Manitoba Sunflower Festival for \$1,000 was also withdrawn and should not appear on the Aging Summary and be moved into the next granting period. Wendy has reversed both grants.

MOTION: Ken Wiebe - moved - Keith Stoesz - seconded - THAT the minutes of the meeting held September 27, 2019 are adopted as circulated with the noted changes. CARRIED.

- 5. Financial
 - The Gretna Arena did not submit enough invoices for the total project cost of \$47,650 on their 2019 spring grant of \$2,000 for upgrades to LED lighting at the Gretna Arena.

MOTION: Angus Klassen - moved - Ken Wiebe - seconded - THAT the Altona Community Foundation pro-rate the \$2,000 grant to Gretna Arena to reflect the actual amount spent and approve a payment of \$1,820. CARRIED.

- Angus presented the attached financial reports and email report to the board as prepared by Wendy. Wendy hopes to have the transition/year end complete by November 1.
- Bank accounts: FY2019 service fees for fund accounts were transferred October 15; Menno H. Friesen Fund only has monies in a GIC so that fund has a balance owing to ACF \$149.57 to be transferred; cheques issued since last meeting: Jenn for September meeting meal, \$53.85 and Oakview Golf Course, \$2,099.50; transferred YIP matching grant \$663; \$65K GIC matured September 30, transferred to platinum savings for investment.
- Balance sheet: platinum savings \$552K; GICs \$824K; \$12,400 in grants payable.
- Income statement: \$103K income for FY2019; \$44K expenses for FY2019; FY2019 net income - \$59K.

MOTION: Angus Klassen – moved – Tracy Klassen – seconded – THAT the financial reports/email report as prepared by Wendy are approved as presented. **CARRIED.**

It was reported at the September meeting the Menno H. Friesen Fund has \$565 to disperse

 Bill thought there should be more dollars accrued. Angus to check with Wendy and report back at the next meeting.

6. Youth in Philanthropy

- The Memorandum of Understanding between the W.C. Miller Youth in Philanthropy (YIP) and the Altona Community Foundation has been renewed for another three years. Agreement was updated and signed by both parties.
- Chris to remain the ACF contact with YIP.
- YIP will again be run through student council with teacher advisors Vanessa Zacharias and Paul Krahn.

7. 24 Hour Giving Challenge

- The 24 Hour Giving Challenge date has been confirmed Saturday, November 16.
- Gifts made to the ACF's unrestricted fund will be stretched by The Winnipeg Foundation and the Manitoba government, \$1 for every \$5 donated.
- ACF can receive a max. of \$2,000 each from The Winnipeg Foundation and the Manitoba government.
- Golden West Broadcasting presented a live action broadcast proposal for the November 2019 Giving Challenge, attached. Chris abstained from voting.

MOTION: Ken Wiebe – moved – Bill Penner – seconded – THAT the attached proposal from Golden West Broadcasting is approved as presented with the live on location time changed to 9 am - 1 pm.

CARRIED.

- · Loren to arrange table in the mall.
- Board members to contact past/potential business donees.
- Jennifer to update website with donation link after the fall granting period.

8. RBC Future Launch Community Challenge

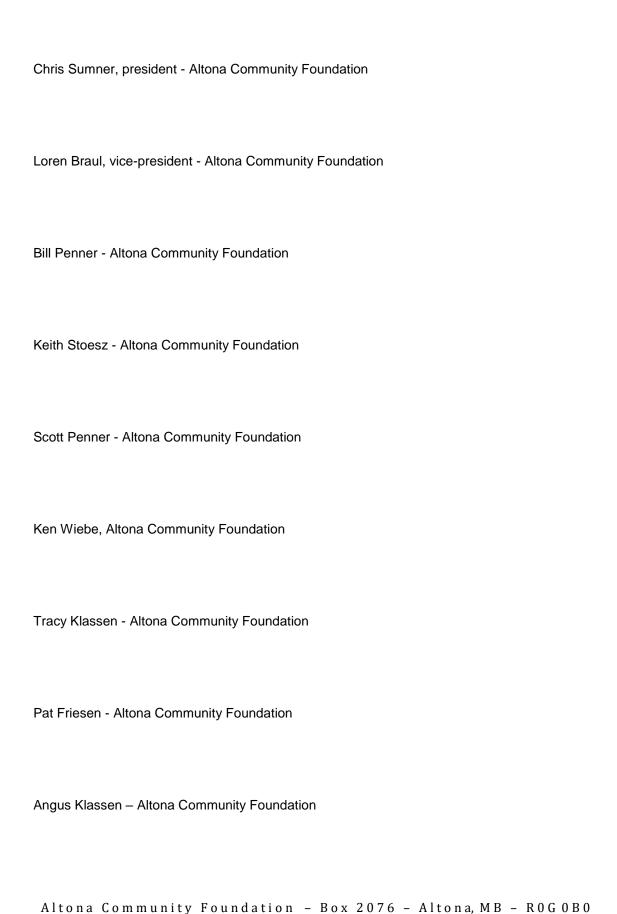
