Minutes of the Altona Community Foundation (ACF) Board of Directors meeting held on Wednesday, November 6, 2024.

Present were: president, Haydon Friesen; vice chair Al Friesen; treasurer, Angus Klassen; Vic Loewen; Leanne Braun; Jo Funk; Shauna Giesbrecht and Ralph Hamm. Regrets: Jonathan Toews.

Call to Order

Haydon Friesen called the meeting to order.

1. Review of the Agenda

MOTION: Jo Funk - moved - Vic Loewen- seconded - THAT the agenda is approved as presented. CARRIED.

2. Review of Previous Minutes

MOTION: Shauna Giesbrecht - moved - Ralph Hamm - seconded - THAT the minutes of the meeting held October 17, 2024 are adopted as circulated. CARRIED.

3. Youth in Philanthropy

- YIP provided the following report via email: YIP will be hosting the intermission snack bar during the school play in the new year as a fundraiser, they also plan to have candy and flowers sold in February for Valentine's Day; a movie night is also in the works.
- YIP will be sending representatives to the ACF banquet on Nov. 14 to help run the event.
- YIP is also hoping to run a "mitten tree" during the W.C. Miller winter concert to collect warm clothing to share within our community - a non-monetary event but still important for our community.
- Jonathan to invite YIP to the December meeting.

4. Financials

- Etransfer was issued to: Jenn, \$743.70 October lunch, Google Workspace, liquor license for banquet, and January to June hours.
- Cheques were issued to: BSO, \$5,000 final installment, KSC, \$10,000 2024 grant installment; 2024 YIP grant to Genesis House - \$400; and 2024 YIP grant to Altona Curling Club - \$250.
- Still waiting for TWF statements to close out our fiscal year.
- Angus presented the attached financial reports to the board prior to the meeting.

MOTION: Angus Klassen - moved - Vic Loewen - seconded - THAT the attached financial reports are approved as presented.

CARRIED.

Wording on letter to fund holders was approved – Jenn to mail out letters.

5. Granting

- 2024 fall granting: 14 applications received, 10 were accepted, four were denied and two were continuing multi-year commitments.
- ACF along with the Menno H. Friesen Fund had \$32,900 to disperse.
- · Vic went through the grant scoring guide with the board.
- Board confirmed the following \$32,900 in grant requests:
 - Access Field of Dreams, ACF, \$1,500 and \$1,400 Menno H. Friesen Fund digital video board
 - o Altona Community Health Centre, \$1,700 physicians office/break room
 - Altona Minor Baseball, \$2,750 clay & clay bricks for baseball diamonds

- o Altona Minor Softball, \$4,500 two dugout roofs
- o Gretna Stars Rec Hockey, \$1,250 skate sharpener
- o Kiddie Sunshine Centre (Main), \$2,200 laptop, floor cleaner
- o Kiddie Sunshine Centre (Centre), \$600 vacuum cleaner
- o Pembina Counselling Centre, \$1,750 three computers
- The Gardens on Tenth, \$3,500 industrial dishwasher
- o Youth for Christ, \$1,750 sports equipment
- o Blue Sky Opportunities allocate \$5,000 for new handivan (multi-year commitment)
- Kiddie Sunshine Centre allocate \$5,000 for 2024 fall payment for 2022 daycare expansion grant (multi-year commitment)

MOTION: Vic Loewen– moved Angus Klassen– seconded – THAT the 2024 fall grant requests are approved as presented.

- Letters and grant check sheets to be handed out at ACF banquet. Jenn to mail other letters.
- Press release to be sent to media.
- The Altona & Area Family Resource did not submit enough invoices for their total project cost of \$2,500 on their FG2023 for \$1,000.

MOTION: Vic Loewen – moved Leanne Braun – seconded – THAT the ACF FG2023 to the Altona & Area Family Resource Centre reflect the actual amount spent and approve a payment of \$840.76. **CARRIED.**

6. Banquet Committee – 30th anniversary celebration

- Invitations have been sent board to give approx. numbers to AI on the invitations they delivered by Friday.
- Al to confirm number of appetizers with Potpourri and order cheese & cracker platters from Co-op by Friday.
- YIP will be sending 5-7 students to help serve.
- Al to confirm set-up time on Thursday.

7. Community Engagement Committee

- Al booked advertising for the Giving Challenge with Golden West and The Voice, Jenn submitted an information ad for the Giving Challenge for the Chamber newsletter and submitted the information for the Chamber's electronic sign.
- Jenn supplied committee with quotes on sandwich board signs, decided not to pursue at this time will review again in 2025.

8. Asset Development Committee

 Angus provided a revised fund policy for the board based on changes at last month's meeting – board reviewed and had no changes.

MOTION: Angus Klassen- moved Ralph Hamm- seconded - THAT the Altona Community Foundation's fund policy is approved as presented. **CARRIED.**

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9. Endow MB Giving Challenge

- Confirmed that cheques can be dropped off at Access CU during the Giving Challenge week.
- Jenn applied online for a donation from Access CU.
- Decided not to pursue sandwich board signs for the Giving Challenge
